### **Honda Dream Team grabs three from three**

Commonwealth Games gold medallist and reigning Bay Classic champion, Rochelle Gilmore has notched up her second win of the Bay Series in round three today, securing the 2011 title with one round remaining.

The Honda Dream Team worked hard throughout the race to ensure Gilmore was in pole position to take the win.

The Honda Dream Team leader said, "I'm really excited about the win today, but it's not just me that's winning. Cycling is a team sport and I could never have done what I've done here without the strength of the Honda Dream Team behind me."

"The competition today was fierce. It was a really aggressive race and it was so much fun because it was very unpredictable and you never knew how the race was going to unfold."

"The Honda Dream Team was in a strong position most of the day and it was a great feeling sitting back there watching the race unfold and knowing that we had everything covered," she said.

Today's win follows Gilmore's victory in round one of the series and a win by fellow Honda teammate, Tiffany Cromwell in round two on Monday.

The Honda team also retains the sprinters jersey after round three, with Peta Mullens taking it back from teammate, Tiffany Cromwell.

Gilmore said tomorrow's final race at Williamstown would present a strong challenge for the team.

"Everybody's going to throw everything they've got at us tomorrow, it's the last day so we can expect a really aggressive race and hopefully we can bring home the series lead and sprinters jersey as well," Gilmore said.

Chloe Hoskins finished second today, followed by Gilmore's Honda teammate Peta Mullens.

Rochelle Gilmore leads the series overall after round three with 29 points.

The final round of the 2011 Jayco Bay Crits will be held at Nelson Street, Williamstown from 1:30pm tomorrow.
