Honda Dream Team wins all at Jayco Bay Classic

The Honda Dream Team has taken a clean sweep at this year's Bay Cycling Classic, with reigning champion, Rochelle Gilmore winning the overall title and the team also winning the sprinters and teams classifications.

Commonwealth Games gold medallist and leader of the Honda Dream Team, Gilmore won the overall Bay Classic title for the third time after taking two of the four stages.

"I'm so proud of the Honda Dream Team. Everything just comes together with these girls, we're a really tight unit. It's a great feeling to have achieved everything here, the yellow jersey, the sprint jersey and the teams classification."

The Honda Dream Team dominated the series from start to finish, with Gilmore's teammate, Tiffany Cromwell securing the sprinters jersey and the team easily winning the teams classification by 47 points.

"There's been strong competition throughout this series. We didn't know what to expect coming into it but it was great to see the girls get out there and do the job every day. We're thrilled with the result."

The Honda Dream Team won three of the four stages of the Bay Classic, following an equally strong performance in the Honda Insight series last year.

"Our ability to consistently perform at this level is a very good sign for the team's future, both this year and in years to come. The Honda Dream Team now have some more races to win starting tomorrow at the national championships, then the Tour Down Under and I'm already thinking about the Jayco Bay Classic next year," Gilmore said.

Rochelle Gilmore finished second in today's race, behind German, Judith Arndt (HTC Columbia).
