Peta Mullens Wins Stage Three

Honda Dream Team member, Peta Mullens won tonight's third stage of the Honda Insight Women's International Grand Prix Series, after fellow teammate Rochelle Gilmore was disqualified.

Gilmore's disqualification followed a heavy fall by Russian, Evgenia Romanuta in the sprint to the finish line.

"I was pleased with the win tonight," Mullens said. "The Honda Dream Team rode a good race but it was disappointing that it ended the way it did after the fall."

Emily Collins crossed the line in second place, followed by Kate Chilcott.

After the third round of the Honda Insight Women's International GP Series, Honda Dream Team member Peta Mullens leads with 27 points, followed by Rochelle Gilmore on 24 points and Evgenia Romanuta on 20 points.

The Series continues with live televised races in Coogee at 2pm on Saturday and Cronulla at 12 noon on Sunday.
